❖❖ About Us

Our Roots . . .

- ❖ The Sanctuary, formerly Glendale Baptist Church, was founded in **1927** at 4502 Gault Place, NE, Washington, DC.
- ❖ The first Pastor of Glendale Baptist Church was Reverend Bernard Botts.
- ❖ Reverend Ernest Miltier became the second Pastor of Glendale Baptist Church in **July 1927**.
- ❖ Under Reverend William H. Gibson, accepting the call to become the third Pastor of Glendale Baptist Church in **January 1933**, the church erected a new edifice at 4504 Gault Place, NE, Washington, DC.
- ❖ In **1976**, under the leadership of Glendale's fourth Pastor, Reverend Abraham L. Colston (installed **February 1964**), the church broke ground on a new edifice "of steel and stone" at 4504 Gault Place, NE, Washington, DC.
- ❖ Reverend Anthony G. Maclin was elected as the fifth Pastor of Glendale Baptist Church in **June 1986**, and was installed as Pastor in **September 1986**.
- ❖ In **1990**, Glendale Baptist Church was able to "burn the mortgage" on the former edifice. Glendale also purchased and renovated the apartment building located at 4505 Gault Place, NE, Washington, DC, naming the complex The Center for Education and Administration.
- ❖ In **March 1995**, Glendale marched from their former edifice to a new church home at 7610 Central Avenue, Landover, MD.
- ❖ In **June 1997**, the Lincoln Technical Institute was purchased and reformed into the Glendale Baptist Church Christian Life Center.
- ❖ In **September 1998**, The Glendale Mass Choir recorded it's first live album.
- ❖ On **January 1, 2000**, members of Glendale "birthed" the Multicultural Worship Center, located at 7752 Landover Road, Landover, MD.
- ❖ In early **2003**, Pastor Anthony G. Maclin received the vision to purchase the 254,000 square foot Hampton Mall Complex in Capitol Heights, MD. This vision became realized, and was officially celebrated at our Groundbreaking Ceremony in **March 2004**.
- ❖ In **2004**, The Glendale Mass Choir released it's second CD, "I Admit, I Worship".
- ❖ On Resurrection Sunday, **April 11, 2004**, Glendale Baptist Church officially became "The Sanctuary at Kingdom Square".
- ❖ In **2009**, The Sanctuary began our "Focus on Giving" Campaign throughout the Capitol Heights area, and continues this effort annually
- ❖ The Sanctuary embarked on the "And Still We Rise" Capital Stewardship Campaign in **2010**.
- ❖ The Sanctuary went overseas to Haiti in **2011** to help rebuild communities as part of the Haiti relief effort.
- ❖ In **August 2011**, The Sanctuary sent large shipments of medicine to Haiti to help fight a Cholera outbreak following the major earthquake.
- ❖ In **2012**, The Sanctuary visited New Jersey to assist in the Hurricane Sandy Relief effort.
- ❖ In **August 2014**, The Sanctuary began "Operation Manifestation", the relocation of The Sanctuary at Kingdom Square to 5300 Crain Highway, Upper Marlboro, MD 20772
